About the organisation:



The European Youth Parliament (EYP) is a unique educational programme which brings together young people from all over Europe to discuss current topics in a parliamentary setting. As a network of independent associations, EYP is present in 40 European countries and organises almost 600 events every year, summing up as almost 1.500 days of EYP activity every year, involving close to 35.000 participants. EYP is a non-profit organisation held alive by thousands of young volunteers all over Europe, making EYP a programme truly for young people, by young people.

Why Horsens:

Horsens is selected as a host city for the 2nd National Selection Conference (NSC) of EYP Denmark for several reasons. Seeing that Horsens is one of the fastest growing cities in Denmark, and that Aarhus is the European capital of culture this year, we want to partner up with both cities in this project. The event:



We are volunteers chosen as Head-Organisers of this event, and have set the preliminary dates to be from 25th to the 29th of October this year. A NSC is a 4-day event that brings together in total around 120 young people, of which ca. 70 are young danes in their final years of gymnasium. The rest are set to be international officials from all over Europe, also volunteering students. The theme of the conference is "Greener together", and we wish to have a very high level of academic preparation also thanks to the cooperation with the Student Research Association of VIA University College.
